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FOLDS OF HONOR FRIDAY RETURNS TO THE 3M OPEN ON FRIDAY, JULY 24

Presented by Huntington Bank, Cub, and Ascentek

BLAINE, Minn. – Spectators are encouraged to wear red, white and blue on Friday, July 24, for the third annual Folds of Honor Friday at the 3M Open, honoring the selfless commitment of U.S. military service members and first responders. Presented by Huntington Bank, Cub and Ascentek, the initiative is part of a PGA TOUR-wide collaboration with Folds of Honor.

A patriotic ceremony will take place at 6:20 a.m. on the first tee at TPC Twin Cities before the second round of competition gets underway. The program will include an Honor Guard presentation and a performance of the national anthem by Emma Carpenter, a former standout on the University of Minnesota golf team and current media personality.

Fans attending Folds of Honor Friday will receive specially designed commemorative pins in recognition of their support for those who serve.

"Folds of Honor Friday has become one of the most meaningful traditions of tournament week," said Hollis Cavner, 3M Open Executive Director. "It's an opportunity for our fans, partners and community to come together in gratitude for the sacrifices made by our military service members, first responders and their families. We're proud to continue growing this tradition while helping support local educational opportunities through Folds of Honor."

Through the 3M Open's support of Folds of Honor, 23 local educational scholarships will be awarded during this year's tournament.

Since its founding in 2007, Folds of Honor has awarded nearly 73,000 scholarships, resulting in more than \$340 million in educational impact nationwide.

This year's featured speaker will be Rodney "Rocky" Sickmann, a retired United States Marine Corps sergeant, former prisoner of war during the Iranian Hostage Crisis and past U.S. National Director for Military and Industry Affairs for Anheuser-Busch. Sickmann was just 22 years old when the U.S. Embassy in Tehran was overrun on Nov. 4, 1979, and he became one of 65 Americans held hostage. Sickmann was confined for 444 days. Today, he works with individuals and corporations across the country to advance Folds of Honor's mission of providing educational scholarships to the spouses and children of fallen or disabled military service members and first responders.

Throughout the day, fans can round up their purchases in the FanShop or make donations via QR code at on-site concessions in support of Folds of Honor Minnesota. Additionally, all military attendees with a valid military ID will receive a 10% discount in the FanShop located at the Main Entrance on Friday, July 24.

The 3M Open's complimentary military ticket program is sold out for 2026. Military guests who secured tickets in advance are invited to enjoy exclusive access to the Huntington Bank Military Outpost presented by Cub and Ascentek, which opens at 10 a.m. and overlooks the 18th hole in Fan Village.
