Q. (In progress) move into that top-70 in the FedExCup and the first step in order to do that is to make the cut here, put yourself in position and you've done that with a really solid round of golf.

CHRIS KIRK: Yeah, thanks. You know, yeah, I definitely would like to make the Playoffs, that's kind of one of many goals at the start of the year. Hasn't been my best year for sure, but I feel like I've been playing some decent golf lately, so excited to have a chance this weekend.

Q. I thought you were in control of your golf ball today, you hit 15 of the 18 greens.

CHRIS KIRK: Yeah, my swing felt pretty good. I didn't drive it quite as good as yesterday, but overall my golf swing feels pretty solid. (indiscernible) a ton of great putts out there, made a few but had a lot more that could have gone in.

Q. Yeah, I saw you hit two really good putts both at 7 and at 8 that easily could have gone. You dominated the par 5s, six par 5s that you played six under par and included an eagle to finish off that opening round.

CHRIS KIRK: Yeah, I thought I made eagle on 18 again today, I hit two really, really nice shots, hit a great putt that just stayed high on me. Yeah, just making good swings.

Q. Going back to the FedExCup list, I have you at 77 on the list, you've been nine in the FedExCup Playoffs, you've been at East Lake the last several years. Is there any reason why the game's been a little bit off this year? You did come close to winning the Rocket Classic.

CHRIS KIRK: Really struggled with my putting the first half of the year, just couldn't find anything, anything consistent. I'd have a few decent weeks at best, but yeah, that was really holding me back.

Made a few minor changes, nothing crazy. More changes to my process of the way that I'm reading greens and the way that I'm approaching putting in general and yeah, it feels really good.

Q. You've made more than 160 feet in putts in the first two rounds, take that with you into the weekend.
