EMILIANO GRILLO (-11)



Q. Emiliano, four under today, just how did that round compare to yesterday's round?

EMILIANO GRILLO: Yeah, I felt like I played really well. Way more difficult than yesterday, way more windy. Same direction, which is kind of nice. You kind of know, kind of playing by memory off the tee. Yeah, a couple really good putts there, especially on 18 after that (indiscernible) shot. Yeah, very happy with the score.

Q. What was your kind of mindset going out there and starting after seeing Michael Kim's 59? I guess it was already posted when you started?

EMILIANO GRILLO: Yeah, definitely wasn't a 59 out there. Maybe somebody playing really well could have shot 64, 63, but I feel like that would have been the lowest. Obviously it takes a lot of good game on a calm day to go out and shoot 59. Everybody kind of dreams of having that number, so congrats to him. Hopefully no more 59s from him after today.

Q. Does it change your strategy or anything when you see that score and you know that --

EMILIANO GRILLO: No, because it was -- you know, it was very different. I mean, I was sleeping when he was shooting birdies out there. I don't know the conditions in the morning, but I doubt it was this windy. When you see the forecast is going to be 15, 20, gusts over 20 miles an hour, you know that you're going to grind for a couple birdies here and there. Five birdies out there today and like I say, I'm happy with the score. I don't think I could have asked for more.

Q. What is your mindset going into the weekend?

EMILIANO GRILLO: Same. I mean, it's going to be warm, so just stay hydrated, that's the main focus. Fairways and greens, that's all I can ask for.

Q. You've been away for a couple weeks. You were just telling me the last tournament was the John Deere and some life-changing events have happened. How have you adjusted to that, the birth of your --

EMILIANO GRILLO: Yeah, it's easy when you're on the road and sleeping more than when I'm at home. Those wake-ups at 2:00, 3:00, 4:00 in the morning are not fun, but it's worth it. Yeah, obviously missing being at home, but this is my job and I love doing it. Just going to give my best while they're not having so much fun at home.



Q. Just with two more tournaments left after this before the Playoffs, is it your intention to play them all?

EMILIANO GRILLO: Yeah, as of now, I'm going three weeks on the road. Hopefully it's only one, I can go home and I could go to the Playoffs, but we'll see. A lot of golf to play. Taking it day by day. I'm in no rush to play the Playoffs, to be honest. Right now, my mind is somewhere else. So it's kind of hard with that, but I'll give my best.
