SEAMUS POWER (-14)



Q. Seamus, 8 under for today. Tell us what you were seeing and how it's built over the last couple rounds to today?

SEAMUS POWER: Yeah, it obviously was a different golf course today. We finished yesterday and our last four, five holes the wind was really starting to gust. It's a tricky golf course and I know the greens are soft, but the rough is still thick and it was tough to get close to the pins towards the end yesterday.

It was different going out this morning. I played with Davis, who got off to a flying start and I was able to just kind of feed off him a little bit, and I felt like I was playing catch-up -- even though how many birdies I made, playing catch-up in my own group. He kind of drove me along nicely and I was able to knock in a couple at the end there to catch up.

Q. How much does it do for your confidence sharing the lead?

SEAMUS POWER: Yeah, I mean look, I probably won't end that way when it's all said and done, but it's great. It's the kind of position you want to be in. That's why we practice, that's why you put in all the hours and stuff. You're going to test yourself tomorrow under tougher circumstances, but I'm really looking forward to it. And it's been a little while, so really can't wait.

Q. Bogey-free round for you today. How important was it to be bogey free and what does that do to drive your confidence into tomorrow?

SEAMUS POWER: Yeah, huge. I made a couple of very nice par saves on 11 and 13, kind of kept my round going so that was really a big turning point. If I missed a couple of those I might have stalled out a little bit. It was great. Anytime you're bogey free on the PGA TOUR, you're doing a lot of good things. It was nice and obviously it helps the score a lot so puts me in a good spot for tomorrow, so hopefully not too many bogeys tomorrow either.

Q. Seamus, what part of your game is giving you the most success or confidence in the last three rounds?

SEAMUS POWER: I feel honestly like everything -- off the tee has been so-so and everything else has been pretty good. Approach the green, around the green and putting have all been pretty strong. I'll do a little bit of work on the range here just to get a little feel going with the driver and then should be good to go.

Q. And if conditions change tomorrow, like the winds here are unpredictable --



SEAMUS POWER: Yeah.

Q. -- does that change your approach, your mindset for the last three rounds?

SEAMUS POWER: In a couple of spots maybe, but for the most part, most years I played here it's been a decent breeze and today was probably the calmest I've ever seen it. I've seen it with some breeze. It obviously played a lot easier today. I know it's going to be a lot hotter tomorrow so it could be a different test, especially with some breeze blowing, but we'll see and we'll adapt accordingly tomorrow.

Q. You talked about playing off of Davis' energy. How did you feel from the energy from the crowd? How did the crowd help you out?

SEAMUS POWER: Most of them were a bit behind us to be honest. Most of them were out there with Scottie, who's probably four or five holes behind us. Obviously with him there was a couple of times we crossed over and you could kind of get a feel for the crowd. No, I think for the most part we had a good vibe going in the group and we were able to kind of use that to our advantage.
