DAVIS THOMPSON (-14)



Q. Davis, birdied the first six of seven holes. What was working well for you today because you looked in control pretty much most of the day today?

DAVIS THOMPSON: Yeah. Put the ball in play off the tee. I feel like I hit a ton of fairways. Everything just helped kind of set everything up, helped me stay aggressive, go flag hunting with wedges. I thought it was going to be a little more windy today, but the wind didn't really rear its head. Was able to just stay aggressive with wedges and just made a lot of putts inside of 15 feet.

Q. Davis, talk about that third shot on 18. You looked a little frustrated on that off-the-fringe shot and how it set up for the last two to make par.

DAVIS THOMPSON: Yeah, kind of got unlucky with the second shot. I hit it right at the flag and just went over the green. It was kind of just like a weird lie. I felt like if I hit it too hard, it was going to go all the way down the hill and didn't want to do that. Just kind of flubbed it. That's kind of the challenge the rough presents out here. You know, can't get bogged down with that, just got to move on. It was a really good day.

Q. A change in the weather with the overcast changing to sun, did that affect anything going down the stretch the last handful of holes?

DAVIS THOMPSON: No, I don't think so. It definitely got hotter out there. I feel like the last five or six holes the sun came out, got a lot hotter. You know, we've been playing in warm weather for three months now so we're used to it.

Q. And what are you thinking now that you have a share of the lead? You're right there at the top going into the last round. How do you approach tomorrow?

DAVIS THOMPSON: Yeah, I mean, we'll see what happens the rest of the way. There's some birdie opportunities coming in. But yeah, it's probably going to take another low round tomorrow to finish this thing off. You know, grateful for the opportunity, looking forward to it.

Q. So you're 99th in the FedEx rankings right now. How does a big week like this set you up for your future on the PGA TOUR?

DAVIS THOMPSON: Yeah, I mean, it would be huge to finish off this week and get a win, but I'm trying not to look at that kind of stuff. I mean, if I get into the Playoffs, great. If not, you still have the fall season left.



Yeah, I mean, a lot of people can put a lot of emphasis on this event because of where I'm ranked in the FedExCup, but I have a lot more opportunities and tomorrow's just all about just staying present, try to give myself a chance to win the tournament.
