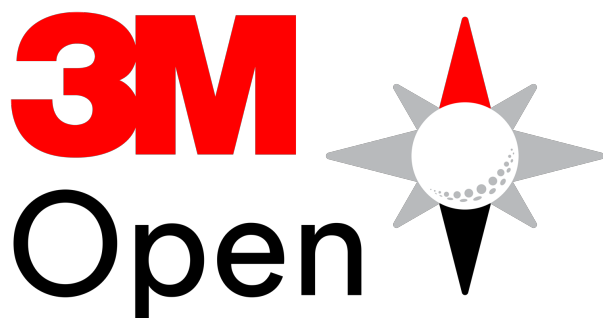

Kurt Kitayama the 2026 3M Open champion seeking to become the first player to successfully defend their title at this event.

Billy Horschel is set to make his second career start at this event and first since 2023 (Finish: T13).

Jackson Koivun is entering this week going 150 holes without a 3-putt the fifth longest active streak on the PGA TOUR.

Jason Day is seeking his third win after missing the cut in his previous start in his PGA TOUR career (MC at the 2026 Open Championship).

Tom Kim is seeking to become the first player from Republic of Korea since himself during the 2022-23 PGA TOUR season to earn multiple wins in the same season (WON 2026 Genesis Scottish Open).

Casey Jarvis is making their 13th career PGA TOUR start coming off his best finish at the 2026 Open Championship (T6).

Gary Woodland has a Greens in Regulation PCT of 78.97%, the highest of any player at this event (min 12 rds played).

Maverick McNealy played 70% of his rounds under par in his first 8 starts of the season compared to just 55.88% in the last nine starts.

Tony Finau the 2022 Champion has recorded 24 of his 26 career rounds at the 3M Open under par (92.31%) leading him to 4 top 15 finishes (4/7), the most of any player at this event.

Scottie Scheffler is making his event debut at the 3M Open, Scheffler has one career win in an event when making his debut (2025 Procore Championship).

Sungjae Im has spent 120 weeks inside the FedExCup Top 70, the second most of any player from the Republic of Korea on the PGA TOUR since 2022-23.

Hideki Matsuyama has recorded two opening rounds of 64 at the 3M Open, tying his lowest opening round in his PGA TOUR career (5 total times).

Max Homa averaged gaining +1.68 strokes tee to green at the 3M Open, the most of any event in his PGA TOUR career (min 8 rounds played).

Jake Knapp has played his weekend rounds 2.07 strokes better (67.89) than the first two rounds (69.96) on the PGA TOUR this season.

Corey Connors ranks 58th in the FedExCup standings entering this week his first time being back inside the Top 60 since entering the 2026 Valero Texas Open.

Steven Fisk is making his first starts since his win at the 2026 ISCO Championship where he earned his second career PGA TOUR win in his 45th start.

Brian Harman has made a Birdie or Better 94.44% of the time when Going for the Green at the 3M Open, the highest of any event in his PGA TOUR career (min 8 rds played).

Lucas Glover has finished inside the top 5 of the leaderboard in each of his last two consecutive starts, marking the fourth time in his PGA TOUR career, he has never finished inside the top 5 in three consecutive starts.

Kitayama hit 28 of his 36 approach shots inside 25' in both the Third & Final Round, five more than the next best in the field.

Max Homa is making his fourth career start at the 3M Open with a best finish of T3 back in 2020. Homa has also never missed the cut in his three previous starts at this event. In his last five starts Homa has jumped into the FedExCup Top 50 for the first time this season.
